

TROPICAL DRY FOREST

The tropical dry forest is one of the most vulnerable and rare biomes of Central America. In Guanacaste, the characteristic six-month dry season leaves the land susceptible to wildfires that often devastate the forest and its wildlife. As if this was not enough, over the past 40 years widespread deforestation and large scale agriculture have reduced the dry forests to a mere fraction of what they were in the past. Undoubtedly this type of forest houses one of the most interesting and complex ecosystems of the area; the natural scarcity of

water has caused wildlife to evolve and thrive in an environment with fewer nutrients than other tropical forests while also maintaining the ability to endure six months of intense tropical rain.


ADVENTURE





WILD MACAWS SANCTUARY

A conservation organization dedicated to the survival of Costa Rica's native macaws. Previously extinct in this area of Guanacaste, the Scarlet Macaw is now back!

The site in Punta Islita is home to the organization's Macaw Refuge and Breeding Center, where rescued or injured birds from both species that can not be released are kept for breeding purposes. Their young are then released into the wild.

Over 50 Scarlet Macaws have been released, creating the now-famous Wild Scarlet Macaw Reserve, a must-see when visiting! the Nicoya Peninsula.

ARENA! VOLCANO

Is a dormant andesitic stratovolcano in Northwestern Costa Rica around 90 km Northwest of San Jose in the province of Alajuela Canton of San Carlos and district of La Fortuna, we are now volcano measures at least 1,633 km 5,358 ft High; it is chronically shaped with a crater of 140 m in diameter. Geologically considered a young volcano and it is estimated to be less than 7,500 years old. The Rain Forest houses 35 species of fish to 135 species of reptile that includes turtles; you can also spot Congo monkeys Colorado and white-face monkeys, tepezcuintles, deers, pizotes and more.. 53% of the species that make up the national bird population live here, a Paradise for birdwatchers.

The amazing natural hotspring brings many benefits and relaxation after a day full of adventures.

TREETOPS ARENAL

BRIDGES + SLOTHS + SPRINGS

We will be ready early morning to start our journey towards La Fortuna, located around 4 hours away. Our first stop is La Fortuna Waterfall, located in a biological reserve with an area of 210 hectares, part of the Arenal Volcano National Park. To observe this splendid 70 mts high waterfall, there is a path of approximately 530 steps, for which the greatest safety is offered and comfortable areas for rest and hydration.

After our hike, we will make our way to the Sloth Sanctuary. It's an outdoor hiking tour, 2 miles of trails, with the help of a naturalistic guide, we'll be finding an average of four to six sloths. Followed by a delicious lunch and a visit to the Hot Springs!

RELAX ARENAL

HANGING BRIDGES + SPRINGS

We will be ready early morning to start our journey towards La Fortuna, located around 4 hours away. The hanging bridges not only offer spectacular views but also give you the chance to admire from treetops to the ground while we search for the many creatures hidden in the landscape. It's a 4 km circuit trail with distances up to 236m and heights up to 70m!

After these amazing hikes, we will enjoy the hot springs. The effects of the minerals in the water provide immediate benefits to our bodies. Increasing its temperature helps us eliminate germs and viruses. This helps increase blood circulation while eliminating toxins through oxygenation. All this is accompanied by an amazing lunch!

MONTEVERDE CLOUD FOREST

The small community of Monteverde is famous for its association with the Monteverde Cloud Forest Biological Reserve. This small town located near the entrance to the Cloud Forest, was founded by the Quaker or vaquera community that migrated from North America to Costa Rica in the 1950s. Although it is currently not a town like others, with houses scattered everywhere. This hamlet has been developed by itself to be able to accommodate a large number of tourists who pass through. The weather here is a bit cold and foggy, because the town is at the top of the Tilaran mountain range, you should bring warm clothes and a waterproof jacket to stay warm!

This natural 'waterwheel' is what maintains Costa Rica's impressive ecosystem; within the cloud forests of Monteverde, Costa Rica, you'll find:

- Tens of thousands of diverse insects.
- 2,500 species of plants (420 are strictly orchids).
- 400 varieties of birds.
- Over 100 types of mammals.

TREETOPS MONTEVERDE

BRIDGES + SLOTHS

After we pick up up, takes around 3.5 hrs to arrive in Monteverde!

This tour will have you walking high in the air, the suspension bridges tour consists of 4 kilometers of trails in which our visitors will find eight suspension bridges of various lengths that vary between 50 and 170 meters. Countless plants, flowers, and animals, you will have an unforgettable time exploring the amazing biodiversity of the area.

The Zipline Adventure will have you exploring the air of the Monteverde Cloud Forest. The Canopy Tour includes 13 cables, including a 1 km long cable, 15 platforms and a Tarzan Swing. There is a total of 4 km of total cable length on the route.

The Sloth sanctuary works in the rescue, conservation, reintroduction, and monitoring of sloths in their natural habitat for over 20 years.

A natural exhibit where sloths can travel freely between paths specially created so that they can roam among the trees and foliage of the exhibition. All followed by a delicious lunch!

BRIDGES + TRAM + ZIPLINE

This tour will have you walking high in the air. Between hanging bridges countless plants, flowers, and animals.

Ride the Sky Tram up the mountain and then get back to the base riding thrilling ziplines, making it a perfect adventure activity with no walking segments – get off and jump on to the next cable. You'll ride 7 cables that go up to 100m in height and 750m in length where you will be astounded by its impressive heights, speeds that go up to 70km/h. You will walk 4 kilometers of trails with 8 hanging bridges, f various lengths that vary between 50 and 170 meters.

GUANACASTE

Guanacaste is considered the tourist destination par excellence of Costa Rica. Guanacaste's beaches are very popular in Costa Rica for their biological richness, their great scenic appeal, and various recreational activities, and ideal hot


RIO TENORIO TYPE III & IV RAFTING

Las Hornillas is found in the foothills of the Miravalles Volcano; here you can enjoy a unique experience of walking inside an active crater!

A unique worldly treasure: a live geologic spa/museum of bubbling water pools, bubbling mud pools, fumaroles and natural mud of different colors found only on this property. You can observe the active crater of approximately 5000 m2, close-up.

Tour to the Waterfalls and Muco Cabro hill is done with tractor and it includes crossing a 40 meter long hanging bridge with impressive views to the waterfall. It also includes hiking on the primary forest trails where you can see a variety of animals such as birds, reptiles, and others. There are a total of 2 waterfalls to visit.
